- 1. Chief Brickell: Called the meeting to order at 9:02.
- **2. Budget reduction:** Chief Brickell explained the Academy has a 5% budget adjustment and a \$84,387.92 savings is needed. The follow options would bring the Academy to that savings.

Option 1: Delay the start of the 110th until February. This would create an \$85,800 savings.

Option 2: Eliminate meal options at the Academy. This would create a \$96,000 savings. Option 3: Delay hiring an Executive Director by three (3) weeks to create a savings of \$19,000, leave the 110th as scheduled but delay the 111th by six (6) weeks to create a savings of \$25,000, and Public Safety will grant up to \$40,000 to the Academy.

Council members agreed to proceed with option 3. Commissioner Schirling will be putting this option into a document to share.
