Narrative:

BENNINGTON POLICE DEPARTMENT NARRATIVE 17BN04852

On Sunday, July 16, 2017 at about 0944 hours I was dispatched to 44 Main St, North Bennington for a family fight. Upon my arrival I met with the female who facebooked her friend to call the police, Danielle Archambault, DOB 04/18/1979. She said that her on and off boyfriend, Jeremy Martin 06/18/76, broke into her house this morning, breaking the handle. She said that Martin is highly intoxicated and it on probation, and might have conditions from court. Danielle said that his has probation conditions to not consume alcohol, and his is "hammered". Danielle said that Martin would run on us. We attempted to get out the back door, but because he broke the handle, we had to go out the front door and around back. Officer Diotte and I located Martin in the back yard.

Officer Diotte was present when we made contact with Martin. He ordered Martin to stop and to come over to us. He did stop and we walked over to him. I could immediately see that he was highly intoxicated. His eyes were bloodshot, he was swaying while talking to us, and I could smell an odor of intoxicants coming from his person. He said that he did go into the house using scissors, but ended up breaking the handle. He said that he lives at the house and the door was locked. He said that he argued with Danielle, but he never put his hands on her. I asked him of he was supposed to be drinking per his probation conditions and he said no.

I told Martin that he was going to have to come with us to the police station. He looked at both Officer Diotte and I and said, "Nope!", indicating that he was not going to go with us. Officer Diotte grabbed his arm and he started to pull away, I then un-holstered my Conducted electrical weapon (CEW) and pointed it at him and told him that he was not going to fight, or he would be tased if he decided to fight with us. Martin then relaxed his muscles and Officer Murawski, who arrived just after I displayed my CEW, placed him in wrist restraints and walked him to my cruiser and placed him in the backseat. Martin admitted that he knew that he was not supposed to drink per his probation conditions. I asked him why he was so intoxicated at 10:00 hours; he said that is how he copes with Danielle. I suggested that he find alternate housing arrangements.

I had Martin blow into the Intoximeter, and his result was a .292% BAC at about 10:00 hours.

Dispatch contacted the on call supervisor for probation and parole and ultimately it was decided that they would be transporting Martin to Marble Valley Correctional Facility. Martin was kept in Bennington Police holding cell until P&P could transport him to MVCC.
